Greetings from cold Michigan! (currently high of 35 and low of 21!)

We hope you had a blessed Thanksgiving with your families and friends; we did. God is good, He allowed Giuseppe to come home to spend Thanksgiving with his family for the first time in many years. Wow, November was a blessed and busy month. We wish you could have been there and had firsthand experience in God intervening and protecting. **What does that mean?**

There was a planned trip for two weeks of teaching and preaching for North Italy. With a detour, the trip should have gone from October 25 through November 6. God intervened; the schedule was changed because the churches had their schedule changed and filled. Giuseppe's trip started on November 4 and went through the 18th. Prior to departing to North Italy, a severe weather storm battered Sicily and caused major flooding throughout the cities (it had been two years of drought).



The exact place where I was supposed to stay for three days (God protected) suffered a catastrophic flash flood where I would have lost my car and more than \$2000 worth of literature. Our brother Daniel lost his car, and others (25) had their cars totaled as well as they were parked in a subterranean garage. Daniel lost all the literature along with some that Giuseppe had shipped months before to Daniel. Your prayers made it happen (purchasing of literature).

You should have been there to see Daniel and his wife when we gave them triple of what they lost in the flood. God is good. We visited the area around them and Giuseppe was able to share the gospel with Maria Grazia, the manager of the BNB where he stayed. God is good.

More than half a million people and no Christian witness in this northern area. Also, Daniel, shared the possible opportunity of helping provide water, by digging a well, in a village in Kenya. We seek the leading of God for this, be in prayer.

Then we took a six-hour ride northeast by Mont Blanc, near the Alps. There, Giuseppe taught on Spiritual Warfare for three days, attendance was in person and some via Zoom (love technology) finishing the following Sunday. Then there were two more stops before reaching Pieve di Soligo (just North of Venice), where we have established a partnership with the local church. In Monza (just North of Milan) the first stop, we gave literature to local churches who outreach to residents and the local Muslim community. Then we went to Pavia (South of Milan) where our brother Elia is preparing to go to a Muslim country to evangelize. We gave him Arabic literature so he can share it with the ones he encounters. In Pieve di Soligo, we also taught on Spiritual Warfare and shared the gospel with many people.

The return trip was eventful; after 13 hours' of driving and arriving in Reggio Calabria at the ferry which traverses the strait of Sicily, an entire family heard the gospel. What I thought would be a couple of minutes of conversation, turned into a half hour of sharing on the bridge of the ferry with Michael. They were going to Sicily for only a day, a birthday, and it was God's day. Pray for Michael and his family. They all received a New Testament and the kids got the children's coloring book Bible.
