## How you are multiplying the Kingdom

For the past two years, we have sent many children to a Bible camp in Sicily. I did preach in Ispica last time I was there and visited the camp. Last year, a young man accepted Jesus as his personal Savior.

We hope to do the same this year. Last year we sent six kids; this year there is the possibility to send between eight and 12 kids. A leap of faith? Yes. We trust that donations will arrive so that these kids can be sponsored to go to camp. Why so many, you may ask? Niscemi. What is that, a password? No, it is a town in the middle of Sicily that was devastated by a landslide that started on January 16th and may have stopped sliding on March 4th.

Between 1,500 and 2,000 people were evacuated in a town of 24,000. Some believers lost their home and possessions. So far, about 500 people are hopeful in returning to see if they can recover their belongings or might be able to save their houses. I will go there and offer to send their kids to camp; otherwise, they won't be able to go. For elementary children, it costs about \$150 for a week of camp; for high schoolers, it costs about \$200. So far, we have enough funds to send three kids. Do pray that the Lord will provide for this cause. God is good and He rewards us in many ways.
